WELCOME

I spent a full afternoon once rebuilding a lead-capture workflow I had already built three months earlier. I'd lost the original to a server wipe, hadn't exported it, and couldn't remember which nodes I'd used to parse the webhook payload. By the time I had it running again, I'd burned four hours on something that should have taken twenty minutes. That afternoon is why this pack exists.

This guide gives you eight pre-mapped n8n AI agent workflows covering the automations that most solopreneurs and small operators rebuild, break, and rebuild again: lead capture, inbox triage, CRM sync, content repurposing, and invoice follow-up. Each workflow is explained step by step - what every node does, why it's connected that way, and where you'll need to swap in your own credentials or logic. You don't need to write code. You do need to read carefully and configure thoughtfully.

What this pack is not: it is not a beginner's course on what automation is or why it matters. It is not a theoretical overview of AI agents. And it is not a plug-and-play magic box where nothing ever breaks. n8n is a powerful tool, and like any powerful tool, it requires you to understand what you're doing well enough to fix it when something goes wrong - and something will go wrong, usually because an API credential expired or a field name changed upstream.

What you'll walk away with is a working library of automation blueprints you actually understand, plus the troubleshooting instincts to adapt them as your tools and business evolve. That second part matters more than the first. A workflow you understand is one you can fix at 9pm when a client is waiting. A workflow you just copied is a liability.

Start with Chapter 1 even if you've used n8n before. The mental model it builds around AI agents specifically - as distinct from standard automations - changes how you'll read every workflow that follows.

READ THIS FIRST

These workflows are starting points, not finished products. Every business runs on slightly different tools, naming conventions, and logic. Plan to spend 20-40 minutes per workflow adapting credentials, field mappings, and conditions to match your actual setup before you go live. That configuration time is the work - and it's far less than building from scratch.
