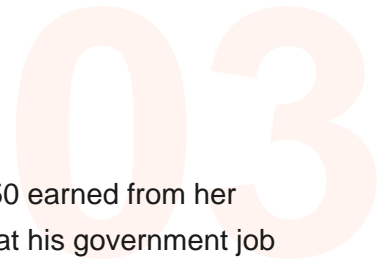

Kemi stared at her phone screen in disbelief. The notification showed NGN 47,850 earned from her TikTok live stream the previous evening - more than her father made in a month at his government job in Kaduna.

Six months earlier, she was just another University of Ibadan student posting dance videos and complaining about ASUU strikes. Her biggest worry was finding NGN 500 for data to stay online. Now, at 20 years old, she was earning more than most Lagos bankers while studying Mass Communication.

"My parents thought I was wasting time on TikTok," she told me during our interview. "They kept asking when I'd focus on 'serious things.' Now they ask me to teach them about social media marketing."

Kemi isn't unique. Across Nigeria, young creators are discovering what international marketers have known for years: TikTok isn't just entertainment - it's the most powerful income-generating platform for creators who know how to use it strategically.

While your classmates argue about which course guarantees employment after NYSC, you could be building an income stream that pays more than most entry-level jobs. While others wait for companies to hire them, you could become the entrepreneur companies want to partner with.

But here's what most Nigerian creators get wrong: they focus on going viral for viral sake. They chase followers instead of paying customers. They celebrate 100K views while earning NGN 0 from their content.
